Award Criteria:

- Minimum High School GPA of 2.5
- Minimum MCC GPA of 2.5 for continued eligibility
- Preference given to financial need

Award Details: Multiple awards may be available

Application Details: Complete applications are due no later than August 16 for Fall semesters, respectively. Notification expected January 31 for Spring semester or August 31st for Fall Semester, with award dissemination expected within 6 weeks of semester starts.

Selection Process: A committee of Monroe Community College faculty and industry representatives under the direction of the Vice President for Workforce Development and Dean of Technical Education.
